- Who is eligible: Nursing students interested in working at Children's Hospital & Research Center Oakland and are :
- a) in their third or fourth year of a RN baccalaureate program or
 - b) enrolled in a Masters entry level RN program at the undergraduate level or
 - c) enrolled in other RN baccalaureate programs (e.g. accelerated program for those who currently hold another baccalaureate degree). Minorities are encouraged to apply.
- What: This scholarship, coordinated by Staff Education and Development, is available to nursing school students. Established in 1992, the fund provides assistance with education costs related to nursing. The award is granted based upon application approval, a written statement of the student's career goals, and academic references and is scored objectively by an evaluation committee.
