## Community Update

### **PROPOSED SATURDAY WORK SCHEDULE FOR GARAGE March 3, 2012 thru April 7, 2012**

### **PROPOSED USE OF 30<sup>th</sup> STREET FOR TRUCKS**

Alta Bates Summit Medical Center's work on our new Patient Care Pavilion and parking structure are going well. To maintain our schedule our garage contractor, Overaa, is seeking approval from the community to work on Saturdays beginning March 3 through April 7, 2012 and the use of 30<sup>th</sup> Street for truck traffic.

We expect this will keep construction activities on schedule and allow us to finish the remainder of the parking garage on time with minimal impact on our neighbors.

Proposed Saturday work on the garage will consist of painting, striping in the parking lot, glass glazing and application of stucco to the outside of the building.

Pouring concrete will result in trucks using 30<sup>th</sup> Street to access the Peralta Pavilion parking lot. We anticipate one mid week day to pour concrete the third week of February and three days during the second week in March to pave the parking lot. A concrete pump and trucks will access the site from the Peralta Pavilion parking lot (on 30<sup>th</sup> Street). This access is required to place concrete in an area that is otherwise inaccessible.

All work will take place during the hours of 8am and 5pm and will include usual acoustical monitoring.

For both of these activities trucks will enter and exit 30<sup>th</sup> Street from Telegraph.

Trucks for all other work on the garage will continue to enter and exit the sites along the approved truck route on Telegraph and Hawthorne. Traffic control provisions currently in place, including parking and/or traffic lanes, will not be affected.
