Goals

To become more proficient at examining, assessing and treating diseases and conditions of the lower extremity.

To become familiar with the diagnosis and treatment of foot problems in an indigent population.

To improve medical writing skills.

Objectives

Where permissible, perform a minimum of 3 focused, problem-directed lower extremity physical examinations per clinic session.

Present a minimum of one patient per clinic session to the attending clinician.

Demonstrate an understanding of Blood Borne Pathogen Standards.

Demonstrate proper debridement technique of hypertrophic toenails, corns and calluses during each clinic session.

Where permissible, write a minimum of three SOAP notes per clinic session.

Present at least one paper on a disease or condition commonly encountered in the indigent population.
