Goal

To increase competency in the evaluation and treatment of neurological disease.

Objectives

Perform and present a minimum of 25 complete evaluations in patients with suspected neurological disease.

Interpret a minimum of 50 clinical labs, radiographs or special studies, including, but not limited to NCV's, EMG's, EEG's.
