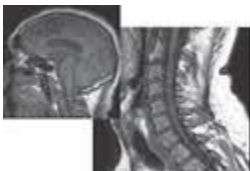

COURSE DESCRIPTION

As the physical therapy profession advances toward direct access, it becomes increasingly important to understand all of the complex data available to make independent proactive decisions. In part these decisions are based on the implications diagnostic tests and imaging have for rehabilitation. Patients expect their physical therapist to be competent in assessing anatomic images and utilize those findings as appropriate for their disease state. Brain and spine imaging is particularly relevant on a daily basis in all musculoskeletal and neuromuscular physical therapy practices. This interactive, hands-on, case-based program will refine your ability to incorporate a systematic approach, integrating imaging findings into your clinical thought process. The course focuses on interactively evaluating brain and spine computed tomography (CT) and magnetic resonance imaging (MRI).



COURSE OBJECTIVES

1. Verbalize and apply a systematic approach to reviewing a brain & spine CT/MRI.
2. Recognize and review brain & spine CT/MRI positive findings related to various pathologies.
3. Discuss rehabilitation considerations related to CT/MRI findings
