

BRN – ESTABLISHING ELIGIBILITY FOR NCLEX

1. Approximately two weeks before the established graduation date, the SMU Registrar will submit the BRN's Program Graduate Roster List to the BRN.
2. Students should submit their application to the BRN no sooner than two weeks before the end of their final term.
3. Approximately one week after the established graduation date, the BRN sends the Registrar a link to upload a new BRN Program Graduate Roster List and unofficial SMU transcripts with degrees posted, so that only graduated students are submitted to the BRN.
4. Any students who did not complete requirements for their anticipated graduation date will be moved to the next possible anticipated graduation date.
5. If the student has submitted their application to the BRN and PearsonVUE, and their application is complete, the student will then be emailed an Authorization to Test (ATT) within 4-8 weeks after the last day of their final term.
