

## How To Access and Link to SMU Shared Panopto Videos


Shared SMU Community videos cannot be embedded in your Canvas course. However, you can add the link of the shared video, to your Canvas course. Follow these steps:

1. Open your Canvas Course.




2. Click "Panopto Library".


The Panopto Library opens in a Canvas frame. Here, you will see the videos associated with your current Canvas course.



- 3. You have two options for finding videos that have been shared with you.
  - **a. Type** the name of the video or Panopto folder where the video is stored.



b. Or, select the "Pulldown Menu" and scroll down to view more folders.




As you type or scroll down, the Panopto folders you own, or are shared with, you start to appear.



## How To Access and Link to SMU Shared Panopto Videos


4. Scroll down the list until you find the Panopto collection you'd like to access.



5. Find the Panopto folder with the video, and click on it.



6. The Panopto folder opens in Canvas. Click on the title or video thumbnail to play.






## How To Access and Link to SMU Shared Panopto Videos

## TO SHARE THE VIDEO WITH STUDENTS IN CANVAS, FOLLOW THESE STEPS:


**7. Select** the Panopto video URL on the player, and **Copy** it. (CTL C) for PC; or (CMD C) for Mac




**8. Create** a Canvas page, and add a link to the video.



- b. Click "link icon".
- c. Paste the Panopto video URL into the field.
- d. Click "Insert".
- e. Click "Save".
