Step 4: Decide what content will be included in the project.		
Step 5: Make sure the content addresses the problem.		
Step 6: Create a storyboard or visual outline the helps map out the course. What elements will be included and where will they be? What text, images, audio, video and other elements are needed?		
Step 7: Create a mock up in PowerPoint or Keynote to see how it will look and function, then create a small part of the course as a prototype.		
Step 8: Get feedback from users before building the entire course course.		
Step 9: Make changes, build the course and publish it.
