

How to Access Reports and Grade Turnitin Assignments

Overview:

The interaction between Turnitin and Canvas continues to evolve and improve. We now recommend that faculty set up Turnitin in assignments using the “Online” submission type instead of “External Tool.” Advanced settings are also now available during set-up. You can grade Turnitin assignments using SpeedGrader, including scoring the Canvas rubric and giving general and detailed comments. You will not be able to use Turnitin’s GradeMark feedback tool in place of SpeedGrader.
