


Employment Rates



78% of graduates 2011-2012 were employed in their specialty within six months of graduation from SMU. (+6% since last collection year, five years out).

82% of 2015-2016 graduates were employed in their specialty within six months of graduation from SMU. (+9% since last collection year, one year out)

94% graduates are currently employed in their specialty. (+3% since last collection year)


